The sound system operates as a music receiver with the songs reaching the loudspeakers wirelessly through Wi-Fi. In comparison to Bluetooth, transferring music via AirPlay generates better audio quality and a greater range.

In addition, the sound system has an FM tuner with RDS and a total of 40 memory slots. With 2 x 50 Watt (RMS) of output, the sound system offers outstanding sound quality for an attractive price. Specially selected components and the high-quality 2-way speakers ensure a first-class sound experience. If you wish, the system can be expanded to include a subwoofer pre-amplifier output.
